I like to teach Half Sashay after Wheel Around because I like using the two calls together. For awhile, I don't call it after Right and Left Thru or Ladies Chain, so as to avoid the Half Sashay becoming a Rollaway.

It is important to stress, from the very beginning, that it is the RIGHT-HAND DANCER that goes in front of the left. The only time I will refer to men or women or boys or girls would be in the context of "Who are the Left-Hand Dancers? This time, it's the boys, so the Boys go in front of the Girls", etc. Otherwise, I always refer to Left- and Right-Hand dancers (LHD and RHD). Still, for the first while, I do only call it with Girls on the Right.

I also teach it from Boxes of 4 – I start every dance and workshop with a Big Circle, eventually getting dancers into Boxes of 4 in a Sicilian Circle. The majority of calls that do not involve 8 dancers, I teach from these Boxes.
