
Once your personal information is entered, click on the green Sign Up button.

Once you agree to the Terms of Use and Privacy Policy, there are 3 steps before you get to your new profile page. You can skip any/all of them if desired.

Step 1 lets you enter your email address and its associated password so that it will have access to your address book.


Facebook will use the email address provided to help you connect with friends and generate suggestions for you and your contacts on Facebook. Existing Facebook users will get an invitation (that they may choose to accept or decline) to be your Facebook friend.












## Having Multiple Email Addresses


Many people have multiple email addresses to stay organized. If you want people to be able to find you as they search for addresses, you can add any/all of your email addresses. First, go to the Account menu in the top right hand corner of the Facebook screen and select Account Settings.
