Callers often use a Boy-Girl (BG) notation to describe the arrangements for Facing Lines. The order is read from left to right of the line near the caller, or within the dancer's line.

"0" Facing Lines (Normal Couples)	= BGBG Facing Lines
"1/2" Facing Lines (Half-Sashayed Couples)	= GBGB Facing Lines
"1" Facing Lines (Boys on Left)	= BBGG Facing Lines
"2" Facing Lines (Girls on Left)	= GGBB Facing Lines
"3" Facing Lines (Normal Couple on Left)	= BGGB Facing Lines
"4" Facing Lines (Half-Sashayed Couple on Left)	= GBBG Facing Lines

There is no standard rule for reading the genders when the dancers are in other formations. Word descriptions might include some Boy-Girl terminology along with clarifying words regarding the point of view and reading order. For example, "Right-Hand Columns from front to back, GBGB" describes the "0" Arrangement for Right-Hand Columns.
