

CALLERLAB COMMITTEE BRIEF

COMMITTEE NAME: Basic/Mainstream Committee

COMMITTEE FUNCTION:

- 1. To develop, maintain, and revise those lists of calls known as the Basic Program and Mainstream Program. This shall be done in accordance with schedules and policies set by the membership and the governing body. The Basic Program is divided into two subgroups of calls named Basic 1 and Basic 2.
- 2. To coordinate with other committees on those items which affect the Basic and Mainstream Programs. This includes cooperative efforts to increase recruitment, enhance dancer success, and promote sociability and enjoyment
- 3. To oversee the creation, review, and revision of definitions for the Basic and Mainstream Programs as needed. Changes are to be made in coordination with the Definitions Committee.
- 4. To develop, maintain and promote additional related materials that may be helpful to callers who use the Basic and Mainstream suggested teach orders and teaching hints.

FUTURE ACTIVITIES:

- 1. The Basic and Mainstream Committee is charged with the management of the Basic Program and the Mainstream Program. New ideas, thoughts and suggestions are always welcome and will be considered. Members are encouraged to send their ideas for discussion during the committee meeting at the CALLERLAB convention
- 2. The Basic and Mainstream Program lists, definitions, and suggested teaching orders shall be regularly reviewed to ensure that all aspects correctly represent the current situation. This includes reconsidering the list and suggested teaching order as the dance world evolves, making sure the terminology is up-to-date, and updating the definitions as needed to describe the actions currently being taught and danced.
