COMMITTEE NAME: Social Connections Committee

FUNCTION:

The purpose of this committee is: “To provide structure and leadership among callers to encourage and promote a wider understanding of the importance of social support and interaction as a significant part of the caller’s responsibility.” Callers can strengthen clubs and encourage social interaction. Callers must understand and appreciate this responsibility if they are to provide the leadership necessary for the success of Modern Western Square Dancing (MWSA).

Square dancing is a community of dancers as well as a recreational activity, and developing social relationships and interactions is important if a community is to survive and thrive. The Social Connections Committee provides the structure, guidance, education and leadership necessary to give callers and square dance groups direction and tools to develop and understand the critical role they play in social interactions and relationships that help drive the success and growth of square dancing.

FUTURE ACTIVITIES: The committee will focus on increasing understanding among callers about the leadership role and responsibility they have to strengthen sociability in clubs and at all dance related events, and to sustain participation in square dancing by actively developing, supporting, encouraging, and participating in social interaction and relations.

The committee will also seek to develop guidelines for callers to adapt and embrace principals of conduct that will help enhance relationships with each other, with dance leaders and dancers. Leading by example in a positive and supportive manner will make our activity far more attractive to join and remain an active enthusiastic participant.
